The Rady Shell is music to the ears of San Diegans, because this project is a permanent bayside outdoor acoustic stage that allows for numerous musical performances. This project is the only outdoor performance space and active park on the West Coast. Patrons can walk down the sunset steps and patio behind the stage for awe-inspiring views along San Diego's bay. Although this project's design was pre-determined, CSM always coordinates with the architect on any recommendations we have for a well executed project.

Originally, CSM's role on this project was installation since the design was predetermined. Due to an outside vendor incorrectly fabricating 40% of the material, CSM re-fabricated those flashings and materials. As a result of the in-shop laser cutting program, CSM can cut aluminum into whatever design the owner requests. This facilitated us greatly when working with intricate radius and angles to create the iconic shell structure. Custom metal was fabricated for the cladding of round steel implemented to contour the project's exterior. The laser was also used to cut aluminum in two smokestacks in the park and the video towers.
